

# Group leaders: Do you like to save money?

Prescription drugs can be expensive. That's why WPS now offers a specialty drug savings program to self-funded group customers through Express Scripts, our pharmacy benefits manager partner.

Through the SaveonSP program, group members who are prescribed drugs on the SaveonSP drug list can achieve significant savings—copays as low as \$0! The self-funded group also realizes significant savings of \$4.50–\$6.50 per member per month.

## How it works

The SaveonSP program targets more than 250 specialty drugs in 30 therapy classes. These drugs are designated as Non-Essential Health Benefits under the Affordable Care Act, which allows copays to be set to maximize assistance dollars from drug manufacturers.

If your specialty medication is noted on the SaveonSP drug list, you must participate in the SaveonSP program to receive your medications free of charge (\$0).

- Your prescriptions must be filled through Accredo, your new specialty pharmacy, or another specialty pharmacy designated by SaveonSP.
- Group members wishing to participate must contact SaveonSP at 800-683-1074 prior to the beginning of the program to avoid delays in obtaining prescription(s) after the program starts.
- If your group participates in the SaveonSP program but your group members choose not to participate, they will be responsible for the full copay listed on the attached SaveonSP drug list. SaveonSP claims do not count toward the plan's deductible or out-of-pocket maximums.<sup>1</sup>

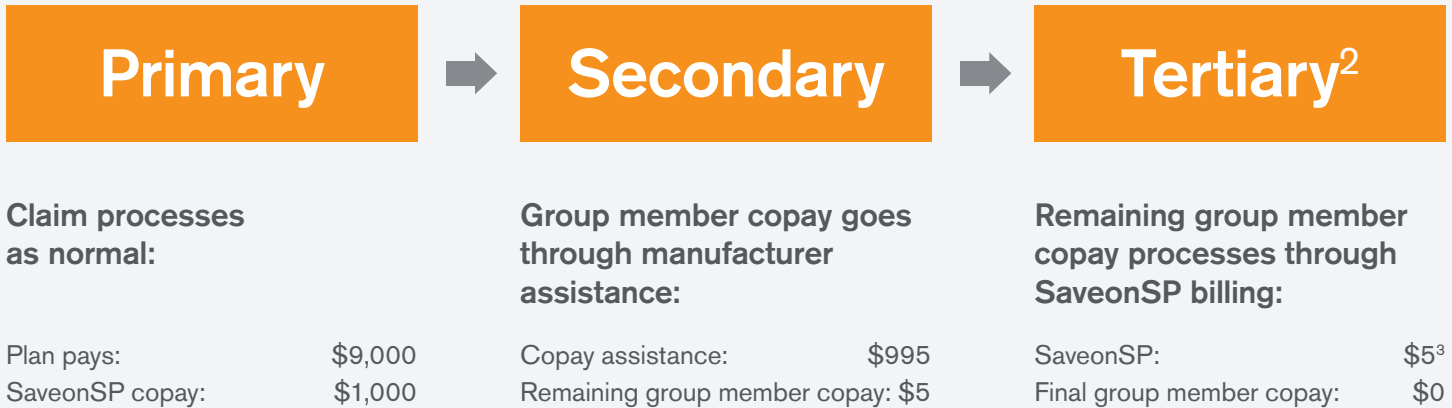

# How claims process through the program

## Specialty drug example

A specialty drug costs \$10,000. For groups without SaveonSP, the standard specialty copay/coinsurance and/or deductible would apply depending on the plan type. For example, a group member with a copay plan could be responsible for a \$250 specialty copay and the plan would pay the remaining \$9,750. For group members with a high-deductible health plan (HDHP), their deductibles must be met prior to plan benefits applying. With SaveonSP, the specialty drug payment goes through a different process.



<sup>2</sup>Tertiary refers to any remaining SaveonSP copay not covered by copay assistance. This may be due to a minimum copay required by the manufacturer or exhaustion of copay assistance benefits.. <sup>3</sup>Amount billed through tertiary is invoiced back to the group. The invoice includes program fees and any tertiary amounts.

## How groups are invoiced

Self-funded groups using SaveonSP receive 100% of their savings at the point of sale. WPS handles invoicing with SaveonSP and Express Scripts, so groups only work with WPS. The group pays a fee equal to 25% of the program savings plus any tertiary costs. WPS provides each participating group with supporting documentation for full transparency.
